Is Hell Real





What does the Bible say?

Both the Old and New Testaments clearly refer to Hell as being a real place. **Jesus Himself** spoke about Hell on **numerous occasions**. (Luke 16:19-31)

Other Bible writers such as John, Peter and Jude wrote about a final judgement day and the <u>reality of</u> <u>Hell</u>. They revealed that God's justice system applies equally to angels and to "Mr Big", Satan himself who will ultimately be apprehended and dealt with. (Revelation 20:12-14)

Why should Hell exist?

This is one of the most **controversial issues** we have to face. Many say "How can a God of love allow such a place to exist". Yet think for a moment. Would any civilized country be without a code of law with penalties for offenders? **OF COURSE NOT!** In fact, an effective law enforcement system is **absolutely essential** in order to have a stable, safe society. Then why should we expect God to run His universe without one?

What is Hell like?

The Bible describes it a number of ways to help us understand different aspects, eg:

Outer darkness Everlasting destruction Lake of fire

The customs of the day help us understand. For example, feasts were held in brilliantly lit rooms, while outside it was pitch dark. If a servant was out of favour, he could be barred from the feast and cast out into outer darkness away from the presence of his master. Thus Hell is exclusion from the presence of God. Even today, remote areas are said to be God forsaken. Actually the **ONLY** God forsaken place is Hell!!!

Who is in charge of Hell?

The popular view that Satan is in charge is simply **Not True**. The reality is that **GOD** is in charge and Satan is going to be an **inmate**.

Why can't we all go to Heaven?

If everyone went there, Heaven would be the same as the present world. Obviously God cannot allow this. Let's face it we think it normal lock people away from society, so why should it be different for God?

Can we get out of Hell after we die?

The straight answer is no. Jesus said that there is a great chasm between Hell and Heaven and it will be **IMPOSSIBLE** to cross over. (Luke 16:26)



Did Jesus come to send us to Hell?

NO!!! The opposite is true. He came on a RESCUE MISSION. (John 3:17)

The fact is that we send ourselves there by going our own way, ignoring God, and rejecting Jesus. On the Cross, Jesus took our place so that God's justice could be fulfilled while making a WAY OF ESCAPE for us.

Out of Court Settlement

We can escape Hell by settling out of court. If we plead guilty now and accept Jesus as our substitute, we will obtain a full pardon. WHAT A DEAL!!! We couldn't hope for more. Could we ever ask for greater evidence of God's love for us? (John 3:16)

God's Rehabilitation Program

God's program is way ahead of any human ideas – He promises to **FORGET** our sins. To crown it all, **He** receives us into His own family.

The Price is Right

We don't need money to hire a top lawyer. Jesus the **GREATEST ADVOCATE IN THE UNIVERSE** is available to everyone – at no charge to us. He has already paid the full price for our pardon. And He guarantees our freedom – the judge is His Father and He has already struck a watertight deal with Him!

Our Destiny is in our own Hands

It's up to us to take advantage of the offer by BELIEVING that Jesus died for our sins and rose again to act as our advocate. And in return we must surrender control of our lives to Him as OUR LORD from now on. (Romans 10:9)
