Who did Jesus claim to be?

In view of the different opinions, we need to know who He claimed to be. The Bible records some remarkable statements He made, such as:

"I and My Father are one". (John 10:30)

He claimed God to be His Father, and therefore put Himself on the SAME LEVEL!

"Before Abraham was, I AM". (John 8:58)

Here He said He was alive before Abraham, who lived centuries before.

"All authority has been given to me in heaven and on earth". (Matthew 28:18)

He obviously believed Himself to be the *SUPREME AUTHORITY*, even in heaven!

In addition, He claimed to be able to forgive our sins and give us eternal life,
